

Bryan Lee Duff

August 2, 1977 – March 18, 2012

A funeral service for Bryan Lee Duff, 34, was held at 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, March 22, 2012 at the First Baptist Church in Wheatland, Wyoming with Pastor Marlin Driskell officiating. Internment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Bryan died near Sundance, Wyoming on Sunday, March 18, 2012.
