

DUFFORD, BERTIE LUETTA TEETER
February 26, 1876-November 23, 1940

Bertied Luetta Teeter was born in Jackson County, Mo. on Feb. 26th, 1876, and departed this life on Nov. 23rd, 1940, having reached the age of 65 years, 8 months and 2 days.

She was united in marriage to E.L. Dufford on November 25, 1896. To this union were born six children, all of whom survive her except Myrtle, who preceded her in death some years ago.

Those who are left to keep her in loving memory are: the husband and father, E.L. Dufford, five children, Anna, Hugh, Lillian, Evelyn and Billy. There are twelve grandchildren.
