

DUFFY, EMMA M. GRAHAM
1886-August 20, 1952

Last rites for Emma (Mrs. R.E.) Duffy, 66, of Glendora, Calif. Were conducted at 3:30 p.m. last Saturday, August 23 in the Methodist church at Wheatland, the Rev. Howard Rice officiating.

Graveside services at the Wheatland cemetery, in charge of the Order of Eastern Star paid final tribute to a life of service, most of which was spent in this community.

Pallbearers were Leo P. Breeden, Lon Stephens, L.M. Strickler, A.R. Fish, A.S. Neely and G.O. Nixson.

Death came suddenly to Mrs. Duffy, who had been spending her summer vacation in Wyoming, dividing her time between Casper, where her daughter, Mar Margaret (Mrs. Robert) King lives and Laramie, the home of her son R.E. (Ted) Duffy. It was in Laramie that she sustained a fall down a flight of steps last Wednesday night, August 20. She lived until about 9:30 the same evening.

Mrs. Duffy came with her husband from Missouri to the Wheatland community in 1915. After the death of her husband in 1940, she taught in the Wheatland schools where for eleven years she was held in affection and respect by the children associated with her.

In 1951 she resigned her position here to take a post with the Brown School for Girls at Glendora, Calif. And to be near her daughter, Helen (Mrs. Leland) Chase. The latter was unable to make the trip to Wheatland for the services.

Besides her two daughters and her son, she leaves six grandchildren.

Mrs. Duffy was a member of the Methodist church, the Order of Eastern Star and the P.E.O. Sisterhood.
