

DUFFY, ROLAND ELMER
April 8, 1883-March 23, 1940

Roland Elmer Duffy passed away on Saturday, March 23, after a very brief illness of heart trouble. He was taken to the Wheatland hospital several days prior to his death, which came as a decided shock to his family and the entire community.

He was born in Maryville, Missouri April 8, 1883 and was united in marriage August 23, 1910 to Miss Emma Graham at Kansas City, Mo.

To this union were born 3 children, Mary Margaret who is now Mrs. W.R. King of Laramie, Helen and Ted Duffy who are students of the University of Wyoming, one sister, Mrs. C.L. Thompson of Wheatland and two brothers, H.T. Duffy of Laramie and Glen Duffy of Wheatland.

Mr. Duffy was at one time a member of the Masonic lodge at Ravenwood, Missouri.

He has been in and around this community for the past 25 years, the past 10 of which he has been affiliated with the Farmers Cooperative Association and for the past several months has been manager of the organization.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon from the Methodist church with Rev. L.W. Flenner and Rev. C.B. Doughty officiating. Interment was made at the Wheatland cemetery with Watson and Dennis in charge of arrangements.
