

DUNBLAZIER, ETHEL E. KEEFE  
March 12, 1892-August 4, 1930

Four children were made motherless Tuesday when Mrs. Ethel Dunblazier was summoned to her reward in her 38<sup>th</sup> year at 1:20 p.m., following an illness extending over a period of eight weeks.

Mrs. Dunblazier, with her family, came to Wheatland from Minnesota about two years ago and located on the Burns farm three and a half miles east and a mile north of town.

The little ones, who with their father survive her, range in age from 13 years to 2 months.

Funeral services were conducted at 10 o'clock today, Thursday, at the Watson Mortuary, by Rev. Orman C. King of the Methodist church and interment was made in the local cemetery.

Mrs. Ethel Dunblazier was called to her reward on August 4, 1930. She was born March 12, 1892 at Arborville, Nebr. She was converted at an early age and united with the Methodist church at Bradshaw and was a faithful member of the same until her death. She was married to Glenn Dunblazier in 1915. To this union four children were born-Gerald Charles, 13, Gertrude Maurine, 11, Donald Keefe, 7, and Dorothy Ellen, 2 months.

Besides her husband and family, she leaves to mourn her loss, a brother, D.W. Keefe, and a host of relatives and friends.
