

Adelaide K. Dunham

A funeral liturgy for Adelaide K. Dunham, 83, were held at 10 a.m. Saturday, Jan. 4 at the Saint Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland with Father Tom Kadera as the Celebrant.

A Vigil for the Deceased will be held at 7 p.m. Friday, Jan. 3, at Saint Patrick's Catholic Church. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Adelaide Dunham died Tuesday, Dec. 31 at the Davis Hospice Center in Cheyenne.

Adelaide was born Nov. 20, 1930 in Mobile, Ala. the daughter of Raymond Thaddeus and Madeline Inez (Wahl) Kearney.

Adelaide and Lee Dunham were married May 12, 1956 in Mobile and moved to Wheatland in 1957. Through the years Adelaide worked both as a legal secretary and in the Platte County Treasure Office, but her true calling was as a volunteer for many causes. Her passion for volunteerism was most evident in her work for the Platte County Memorial Hospital Auxiliary and for her church, Saint Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland. As a life-long and devoted Catholic, she was honored by serving Mass at Saint Peter's Basilica in Rome. This was one of her trea-
