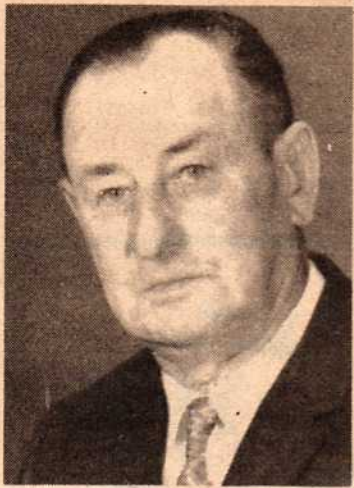


John Dunham Services Held

John R. Dunham, A Wheatland resident since 1913, passed away Thursday, December 2, 1976, enroute to Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne. He was 72. Funeral services were held Saturday, December 4, 1976, at the Schrader-Prell Chapel with Rev. Dan Barcus officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
