

DUNHAM, LOLA DOVE
June 6, 1893-December 2, 1918

Mrs. Lola Dove Dunham, wife of Roy A. Dunham, who lives on a ranch east of Wheatland, died Monday, Dec. 2, of influenza, age twenty-five years. Funeral services were conducted by the Rev. C.H. Frame at the McCallum Mortuary, at two o'clock, Wednesday afternoon, and the remains were laid at rest in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Dunham was born June 6, 1893, in Columbus, Ohio, where she spent her early years. She lived a short time at Enid, Oklahoma, and later she returned to Alva, Oklahoma where she married Roy A. Dunham. In 1918 they came to Wheatland where they settled on their present ranch. She leaves, besides her husband, a father, mother, sisters, two brothers and three small children to mourn her loss.
