Miss Dorothy Mae Elwood, 21 year-old daughter of W.I. Elwood, of the Glendo-Cassa vicinity, passed away in Wheatland last Friday. Miss Elwood had been ill since November of last year.

Funeral services were held at the Union-Congregational church in Glendo, Sunday, January 21<sup>st</sup>, at 2 o'clock.
