

ENGER, MYRTLE MAE OLMSTEAD
October 31, 1903-July 18, 1975

Mrs. Myrtle Mae Enger passed away Friday, July 18, 1975, in Sedro Wooley, Washington after an extended illness. She was 71. Funeral services will be conducted by Mr. Daniel Barcus at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Home in Wheatland, Wednesday, July 23, 1975, at 2:00 p.m. Interment will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Enger was born in Gregory, South Dakota October 31, 1903. Of the Methodist faith, she had been a resident in Wheatland for some time, coming here from Chugwater. She and her husband, Clayton Enger owned and operated the small grocery store and filling station, Clayton's Place, about 12 miles southwest of Wheatland for the last 8 yrs. Mr. Enger preceded her in death March 28, 1974.

In death, she is survived by three sons, Elmer, Theodore and Clifford Johnke, all of Wheatland; one brother, John Olmstead of Slater; two sisters, Ethel Enger of Acme, Washington and Edith Harkness of Van Zandt, Washington; five grandchildren and one great grandchild.
