

ENGLISH, FRANK L.

August 27, 1907-February 4, 1974

Rosary services were held for Frank English Wednesday evening with a funeral mass held following Thursday morning, February 7, 1974, at St. Patrick's Church. Monsignor F.J. Kimmett said the 10:00 a.m. Mass. Pallbearers were Bill Howard, Ed Howshar, MD, Larry Woodcock, Bill Baker, Jack Montgomery and Carl Wilson. On January 8, 1932, he exchanged vows with Jessie Fellows at Broken Bow, Nebraska where the couple lived before moving to Wheatland in 1945. Frank was an active Catholic and a member of the Knights of Columbus.
