

ESCOBAR, BERTHA FLORENCE HOLLEN

April 10, 1880-December 5, 1925

Mrs. Manuel Escobar of Uva died Saturday, after a siege of pneumonia lasting only a few days, and the funeral was held in Wheatland Sunday, with Rev. H.E. Shepherd in charge.

Mrs. Escobar was born April 10, 1880, her maiden name being Bertha Florence Hollen. In early life, she was married to Charles Gerard, and to this union was born one daughter, Mrs. Margaret Dodd of Casper.
