October 28, 1890-November 11, 1960

Funeral services were conducted from the Schrader chapel at 2:00 p.m. Monday, for Paul Eshom, 70, who passed away at the Platte County Memorial Hospital November 11, 1960. Mr. Eshom had entered the hospital five days before his death.

Born in Kansas, October 28, 1890, the son of George Thomas and Flora Arthur Eshom, Mr. Eshom had lived in this community since 1904. He was a rancher and a veteran of World War I.
