

FAY, BENJAMIN C.
1860-March 24, 1943

Benjamin C. Fay, 82, who had been a resident of Wheatland for many years, died Wednesday evening at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Al Erlandson, with whom he had been making his home for some time. Although his health had not been good for the past few years, his condition was not serious until two weeks ago, when he began to fail steadily. He had been confined to his bed for most of the last year.

Mr. Fay is survived by Mr. and Mrs. W.F. Jones, brother-in-law and sister of Fruitland, Ida., two nieces, Mrs. Al Erlandson of Wheatland and Mrs. Sam Wagner of Montana; and two nephews, Lester Jones of Wheatland and Kenneth Jones, now of Dawson Creek, B.C. His son, Benjie Fay, died in August, 1941, following an automobile accident and his wife preceded him in death about ten years ago.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Congregational church, with arrangements in charge of Watson and Dennis.
