August 20, 1882-November 1, 1932

Wheatland and community was shocked Tuesday night when the news of the sudden death of Mrs. B.C. Fay was received. Mrs. Fay, who lives just east of Wheatland, had been ill only a few days and many of her friends were not aware of her illness.

Funeral services will be held from the Congregational church Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. R.E. Morgan will deliver the final rites. Burial will take place in the Wheatland cemetery and arrangements are in charge of the Lydia Watson Funeral Home.

Mrs. Fay had a wide acquaintance over this section of the county as she had lived here a number of years. She, together with Mr. Fay, had developed an enviable reputation for raising a delicious type of cantaloupe, and "Fay's Melons" are known all over Wyoming.

Besides her husband, she is survived by one son, Benjamin, Jr.; four sisters, Mrs. Judker of Hooper, Nebr.; Mrs. Ada Meyers of Sioux City, Iowa; Mrs. Willard Jones of Wheatland; and Miss Jessie Mendenhall of Hooper, Nebr.
