

FERGUSON, FRANCIS A.
March 30, 1898-October 8, 1967

Francis A. Ferguson of Denver, Colo., passed away on Sunday, Oct. 8, at Colorado General Hospital following an extended illness. Mr. Ferguson was a resident here from 1910-1950, and had lived in Denver since. He was born in Denver March 30, 1898. He was married to Edna Irene Heyer on August 11, 1936 at Wheatland. She preceded him in death on Aug. 28, 1967. Mr. Ferguson was a retired farmer, and was affiliated with the Catholic Church.
