

FITZ, FREDERICK A.
August 1, 1860-January 13, 1914

Frederick A. Fitz, one of the highly respected citizens of Wheatland and one of our leading businessmen, passed away on Tuesday evening, Jan. 13, 1914, after an illness of several months duration, death being caused by dropsy.

The deceased is survived by a daughter, Miss Bessie Fitz, of this place, and a brother, Charles Fitz of Cheyenne, plus innumerable friends and acquaintances throughout this section of the state who will be pained to learn of his death.

Mr. Fitz was about 60 years of age and for many years was a resident of Cheyenne where he held a position as undertaker with the Warren Mercantile Company. He moved to Wheatland several years ago since which time he had been conducting a furniture and general store at this place.

Funeral services were held yesterday at one o'clock at the Congregational church, being conducted by Rev. R.F. Paxton, and were largely attended by citizens of the town. The stores were all closed during the funeral as a tribute to the high character and esteem in which the deceased was held. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery.

The services were very impressive and many beautiful floral offerings were presented by friends of the family.
