

FLECK, ANTONE J.
July 17, 1919-July 26, 2010

A celebration of life will be held at 3 p.m. Friday, July 30, at First United Methodist Church in Eugene for Antone J. "Tony" Fleck of Eugene, who died July 26 of heart failure. He was 91.

He was born July 17, 1919, in Crosby, N.D., to Ralph and Amelia Hilfer Fleck. He married Josephine Anderson on May 15, 1943, in Wheatland, Wyo.

He graduated with a master's degree in elementary education from San Diego State. He served in the Army as a staff interpreter in the prisoner of war camps in Camp Trinidad, Colo., during World War II. He worked as an elementary school principal in Escondido, Calif.

Survivors include his wife; a daughter, Antonia "Nia" Fleck of Eugene; a son, Christopher "Chris" of Columbus, Mont.; three sisters, Frances Stricker of Torrington, Wyo.; and one grandchild. A son, Gregory Antone Fleck, died in July 1945 and a daughter, Victoria Leigh, died in June 1974.
