

FLODIN, JOHANNA SOPHIA  
January 13, 1857-November 11, 1945

Mrs. Johanna Sophia Flodin died at the home of her son seven miles north of Chugwater Sunday evening at five p.m., November 11, at the age of 88 years.

Born in Sweden, January 13, 1857, she came to this country 63 years ago and has been a resident of the Chugwater community since 1914 with the exception of seven years spent in Denver.

One son, Ruddy J. Flodin of Chugwater and six daughters, Mrs. F.E. Lindercrantz, Orange, Calif., Mrs. E.S. Williams, Los Angeles, Calif., Mrs. T.H. Dohrse, Omaha, Nebr., Mrs. L.E. Havens, Santa Ana, Calif., Mrs. Alvhid Jacobson, Larchmont, N.Y. and Mrs. J.D. Wilcocks, Anaheim, Calif.; and three grandchildren. Mrs. Dohrse was the only daughter able to be present at the services.

Casketbearers were Magnus Larson, Russell Staats, Erving McConnell, Fred Cashner, I.O. Miller, and Carl Good; and Curtis Templar, Leonard McDonald, and L.C. Johnson were honorary pallbearers.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon in the Schrader mortuary with the Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
