Services for Timothy Andrew Flynn will be held Thursday, Nov. 29 at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland at 10:30 a.m. with Father Cletus Prado officiating. Rosary services will be at the church at 7:30 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 28.

Flynn died as a result of injuries sustained in an auto accident near Moneta on Nov. 25.

Born in Wheatridge, Colo., July 29, 1966, Tim was the son of Edwin "Ray" and Darlene Flynn of Wheatland. In 1968 the family moved to Wheatland where he attended school, graduating from high school in 1984.

He worked as a life guard at the city swimming pool, and was very active in sports on the varsity basketball team for two years.

He was a member of the Entertainers, and was in the select Wheatland High School choir for two years. In 1983 he began to serve as altar boy in St. Patrick's Catholic Church, and served his church until he was out of high school.

He was attending Northwest Community College in Powell on a Physical Education Scholarship.

He is survived by his parents; four brothers: Matt, Chris, and Ryan of Wheatland, and Pat of Laramie; his paternal grandmother Margaret Flynn of Wheatland; and his maternal grandmother Mrs. Jim Angle of Wheatland.

He was preceded in death by his grandfathers Bernard Flynn and Don Olsen.
