

Mrs. A. O. Franzen Dies Here Wednesday

Mrs. A. O. Franzen, 77, died at the Wheatland General hospital on Wednesday following an extended illness. She was born in Esterbeck, Rogger, Sonderygland, Germany and came to the United States in 1892. In 1894 she was united in marriage with Andrew O. Franzen at Friend, Nebraska. She had been a resident of this community for seven years coming here from Nebraska, and made her home five miles west of Wheatland.

She is survived by her husband, Andrew O. Franzen; three daughters, Mrs. Henry Christensen, Litchfield, Nebr., Mrs. Carl Peterson, Ringstead, Iowa and Mrs. Virgil Vogt of Wheatland; four sons, Frank, Harry, Criss and Einer, all of Wheatland; and five grandchildren. A son and a daughter preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held at the Schrader chapel on Saturday, January 11 with the Rev. W. W. Maxwell officiating. Burial will be in the family plot in the local cemetery. *Sc*
