

FRESORGER, ALEXANDER, SR.
December 23, 1874-November 5, 1958

Funeral services will be conducted from the Schrader Chapel for Alexander Fresorger, Saturday, November 8, at 11:00 a.m. with Rev. Daniel T. Winger officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Fresorger was born in Russia December 23, 1874 and passed away in Wheatland November 5, 1958, following a short illness. He was a retired farmer and had made his home in Wheatland since 1931, coming here from Ft. Collins, Colo. He met his wife, Charlotte, and married in Grimm, Russia, 56 years ago, October 23, and came from Russia to Wisconsin in 1911 and living there until 1920. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church.

Surviving are his wife Charlotte; six sons, Alexander, Jr. and Henry of Wheatland, August of Riverton, Paul of Scottsbluff, Chris of Gillette and Albert of Sheridan; one daughter, Mrs. Dave Dinges of Wheatland, twenty-two grandchildren and twenty great grandchildren.
