Services for Mary Fresorger, ¹⁻³⁰⁻¹⁹⁸⁹77, who died in Wheatland Jan. 30, 1989, were held Thursday, Feb. 2, 1989, at 2:00 p.m. in the United Church of Christ with the Rev. Dr. James S. Vuocolo officiating.

Born in Wheatland Sept. 2, 1911, she was the daughter of George and Anna (Derr) Dinges. She married Alec Fresorger on Aug. 8, 1931, at Torrington. Alec and Mary homesteaded in the Goshen Hole area, lived in Lingle for a period of time and then moved to Wheatland. In 1969 they moved to Gillette and returned to Wheatland in 1981. In 1984 they moved to Cheyenne and returned to Wheatland in 1988.

She was a charter member of the Women of the Moose and was an active 4-H leader for 11 years.
