

Funeral services held for George Roy Gamblin Feb. 10

Graveside services for George Roy Gamblin, 85, who died in Wheatland, February 10, 1988, were held in the Wheatland Cemetery, Saturday, February 13, 1988, at 10:00 a.m. with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating.

Mr. Gamblin was born in Salem, Nebraska, November 26, 1902, the son of Richard J. and Lucy (Wisdom) Gamblin. He came to Wyoming in 1920 to farm and ranch in Goshen County. He moved to the Wheatland area in 1941 where he ranched and retired in later years. He and Cecelia Govern were married in 1933.

He was a lifetime member of the Moose Lodge and was also a member of various livestock organizations.

Survivors include his wife, Cecelia Gamblin of Wheatland, a son, Roy Gamblin of Wheatland, a daughter, Marietta Gray of Ojai, California, nine grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by 3 brothers and five sisters.

A memorial in his name has been established to the Platte County Senior Citizens Center. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home of Wheatland was in charge of arrangements.
