Services for Henry Geringer, 74, who died in Greeley, Colo., Tuesday, Dec. 14, 1982, were held Saturday, Dec. 18, 1982, at 10:30 a.m. in the Trinity Lutheran Church in Wheatland with Pastor Emmet Rogness officiating.

Mr. Geringer was born March 11, 1908 in Rocky Ford, Colo., the son of Gottlieb and Margaret Geringer. When he was young, he moved with his family to Platteville, Colo., where he farmed with his father. The family moved to Wheatland in 1926 and Henry farmed with his father for three years.

He married Elizabeth Eichler Dec. 6, 1931, in Wheatland, and the couple operated their own farm here until his retirement in 1979. He and his wife moved to Greeley, Colo., early in December and he died in their new home.

He was a member of the Wheatland Co-Op Association and was nominated Farmer of the Year for the State of Wyoming several years ago.

Besides his wife he is survived by a son, John R. Geringer of Wheatland; three daughters, Darlene Fabricius of Greeley, Colo., Margaret Davis of Los Alamos, N.M., and Geraldine McClun of veteran; three brothers, Gottlieb of Wheatland, Jake of Greeley and Albert of Arvada, Colo.; four sisters, Mary Martin of Greeley, Katherine Zeiler of Brighton, Colo., Elizabeth Drury of Wheatland, and Helen Reidel of El Cajon, Calif. and by 13 grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by an infant son and by a brother, John.
