

GILLAM, EMMA LOUISE WENGERT

August 24, 1887-May 15, 1954

Funeral services were conducted at the Methodist church Tuesday for Mrs. Emma Louise Gillam, 66, who died at Memorial hospital in Cheyenne, May 15. Officiating at the three o'clock service was Rev. Howard Rice. Mrs. Gillam's grandsons served as active pallbearers and honorary pallbearers were Everett Pritchard, Andy Roskie, Robert Harman, Marvin Fisher, Earl Richards, and Frank Scott. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
