

GOETZ, ADAM

June 23, 1889-November 23, 1957

Adam Goetz, Sr. passed away November 23 in Basin after a prolonged period of illness. Services were held Tuesday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock in the Evangelical & Reformed church with Rev. Henry Baumgartel of Scottsbluff officiating and Rev. Dan Winger assisting.

Mr. Goetz was born in Hussenlack, Russia on June 23, 1889 to Adam Goetz and Elizabeth Wassenfelder Goetz. He immigrated to Canada in 1912 and came to the United States in 1914. He married Margaret Nickel in Scottsbluff, Nebr. in 1915. He had been a resident of Wheatland since 1919.

The deceased is survived by his wife, Margaret; two daughters, Molly Bach of Wheatland and Laura Hurst of Bethany, Mo.; two sons, Fred Goetz and Adam Goetz, Jr., both of Cheyenne; and seventeen grandchildren. A daughter, Rose Horvath, preceded him in death on August 16, 1952.
