

GOETZ, MARGARET NICKEL

June 5, 1898-January 15, 1967

Mrs. Margaret Goetz, a Wheatland resident since 1930, succumbed to an illness in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on January 15, 1967 at the age of 68. She was born in Russia on June 5, 1898 and was a member of the United Church of Christ.
