

GOODRICH, ARLO SHERIDAN  
November 11, 1898-June 3, 1964

Death came suddenly early Wednesday morning to one of Wheatland's earliest residents, Arlo Sheridan Goodrich, age 65, of a heart attack at his home.

Goodrich was born November 11, 1898, to Charles W. Goodrich and Belle Sappington Goodrich, two of Wheatland's early settlers. His father made the bricks for the first brick buildings erected here, and was one of Wheatland's first contractors. Arlo followed in his footsteps, and operated a building contractor business known as Goodrich Construction Co.

After his marriage, he and his wife lived in Casper for nine years, before returning to Wheatland. He was a veteran of World War I.

He is survived by his wife, Marian L. Goodrich; one daughter Meredyth Goodrich, Aspen, Colo.; one son, Neil of Lander; a brother, Leon of Casper; and two grandchildren, Charles and Ronald Goodrich of Casper.

Services will be held from the Schrader chapel Saturday afternoon at 2 p.m. with Rev. Ralph Martin of the First Baptist church officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
