

GRAEFE, MAGDALENA MILLER
November 7, 1874-November 15, 1936

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon for Mrs. Richard Graefe who died Sunday following a stroke.

Magdalena Miller Graefe was born November 7, 1874 in Germany and died Sunday, November 15, 1936 at the age 62 years, 8 days.

Coming to the United States with her parents at the age of 6 years, they settled down in Leavenworth, Kansas where she lived until after her marriage July 14, 1898 to Richard Graefe. The couple moved to Goodland, Kansas where they lived about three years before moving to Wyoming in 1902 where they have since made their home, living west of Wheatland.

To this union were born 2 children, Mrs. Sophie Miller of Lander and Gustave of Wheatland.

Mrs. Graefe was loved by all who knew her. She was honest and industrious and cheerful and lived for what she could do for others.

Besides her husband and children Mrs. Graefe leaves to mourn her loss two grandchildren and one sister, Kate Werner of Alderwood, Washington.

Funeral services were held from the Congregational church with Reverend Flenner officiating. The Watson Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements. Burial was made in the Wheatland Cemetery.
