Lewis Graham 45, a one time resident of Wheatland took his own life Wednesday morning, July 18, at his Laramie home, death resulting from a self-inflicted bullet wound.

Mr. Graham had resided in Wheatland until 1940, when he and his family moved to Colorado and then to Laramie, where they lived for approximately a year.

He is survived by his wife, Gladys; four children, Edwin who is stationed with the armed forces in North Carolina, and Norma, Buddy and Sharon all of Laramie; his parents Mr. and Mrs. L.D. Graham of Wheatland; two brothers, Roy of Wheatland and Truman of Joplin, Mo.; eight sisters, Mrs. Elma Yost, of Missouri; Mrs. Bessie Lake and Mrs. Evalene Roberts of Manhattan, Kan., Mrs. Arizona Winters of Los Angeles, Calif.; Mrs. Velma Cohen and Mrs. Fern Murphy of Wheatland; Mrs. Audrey Fulk of Worland; Mrs. Fay DeMille of Montana.

The body was brought by Schraders to Wheatland today (Thursday) and services and burial will be here. Arrangements were not complete at noon today.
