

GRANT, JOHN
?-January 3, 1905

John Grant passed away at the home of T.P. Lawrence on Slate Creek on Tuesday night, January 3rd, at two o'clock, death being caused by a stroke of paralysis.

Mr. Grant was a pioneer resident of this section, coming to this country in the early days. He was born in Scotland, residing a number of years in Motherwell, Scotland, before coming to America, and was 79 years of age at the time of his death.

The deceased leaves three children who live in Pennsylvania, Mrs. Stevens of Mount Pleasant, Mrs. Smith of West Newton and Thos. Grant of Turtlecreek, Pennsylvania. He was also an uncle of D. Grant and Mrs. Jeanie Payne, of this place and Mrs. Robt. Grant of Chugwater.

The deceased had been a member of the Christian church during his life, and funeral services were held at the Congregational church in this city yesterday at two o'clock, interment being made in the Wheatland cemetery.
