

GRANT, ROBERT  
May 22, 1847-September 22, 1921

Robert Grant, who had been ill at his home for some time past, died on Thursday morning, Sept. 22. Funeral services were conducted Saturday from the Congregational church, Rev. R.F. Paxton officiating, and the body laid at rest in the Wheatland cemetery.

Deceased was born in Scotland, May 22, 1847. He came to Wyoming 42 years ago and settled on a ranch near Chimney Rock. In 1866, he was united in marriage with Margaret Mitchell, and to this union seven children were born, three of whom preceded their father to the better land. The four surviving him are Mrs. Clara Chase, Robert M. Grant, Duncan Grant and Harry Grant.

Since early manhood, Mr. Grant had always been actively associated with religious work, having been one of the youngest active members of the Congregational church before coming to America. For some years he had been suffering from diabetes and for the last seven months had been confined to his bed. His life was full of good deeds and he has gone to a well earned reward.
