

Edythe Curtis Graves, 1907 to 1997

Graveside services and interment for Edythe Curtis Graves, 89, were held on Monday July 14, 1997, at 10:30 a.m. with Terry Harris of the Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses officiating, at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland, Wyo.

Mrs. Graves died Thursday, July 10, 1997 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

She was born Nov. 22, 1907, in Broken Bow, Neb., the daughter of Sterling Lewis and June (Huffman) Curtis. The family bought land and moved to Wheatland in 1914. She married William C.
