

MRS. M. E. GREENLEE

Auryldah Ella Greenlee, mother of Mrs. Duncan P. Grant, of the Chugwater vicinity, passed away at the home of her daughter Friday, November 17th. Mrs. Grant had been ill for the past six years.

Auryldah Ella Sinclair was born in Avoca, Iowa, March 29, 1857, and at the time of her death was 75 years, 7 months and 19 days of age. She was united in marriage to Mills E. Greenlee December 25, 1875 and to this union were born six children, five of who survive her: Burton Greenlee, Chugwater; Mrs. Ella Billing, Gray, Iowa; Ernest Greenlee, Wheatland; Mrs. Viola Chase, Cheyenne; Mrs. Cora Grant, Chugwater. Robert Harvey Greenlee, 31, deceased.

Mrs. Greenlee is also survived by two sisters: Mrs. J. C. Miller Avoca Iowa; Mrs. Jessie Mack Council Bluffs Iowa and one brother, Will Sinclair of Oakland, Iowa. She leaves eighteen grand children and five great grand children. Her happy, cheery disposition created many friends who join with relatives in sorrow occasioned by her departure.

Funeral services were held in the Methodist Episcopal church in Wheatland, Sunday, November 19, with Rev. Noyce of Wheatland and Rev. Hooper of Chugwater in charge. Interment was made in the family lot in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge.

In 1905 the family moved to Wyoming from Iowa and settled on the Wheatland Flats where they made their home until 1914 when they moved to a location near Chugwater. Later due to ill health Mr. and Mrs. Greenlee moved to the home of their daughter. Mr. Greenlee died in August of 1930.
