

GUDAHL, OSCAR BERNHARD  
March 18, 1892-October 20, 1973

Funeral services were held Saturday at 10:00 a.m. at the First Christian Church with Rev. Archie Stevenson officiating.

Mr. Gudahl, 81, of Slater, passed away Thursday, October 18, 1973 at the Veteran's Hospital after an extended illness.

Mr. Gudahl was born in Oldham, South Dakota on March 18, 1892. He married Grace V. Broyles December 25, 1920 in Hutchinson, Kansas. He homesteaded in Slater in 1914 and lived here since. Mr. Gudahl was a World War I veteran. He was a member of the Christian Church. Mr. Gudahl was office manager for over 30 years in the Platte County farm programs (ASCS). He helped with the organization of the Wheatland Irrigation District and served for years on the board.

He is survived by his wife, Grace, Slater and children, Mrs. Gus Settell, Wheatland; Mrs. Kenneth Parriett of Bayard, Nebraska; Victor Gudahl, of Slater; Richard Gudahl of Gering, Nebraska; Don Gudahl of Wheatland; Gene Gudahl of Cheyenne; and Andy Gudahl of Monte Vista, Colorado; and two brothers, Sam Gudahl of Howard, South Dakota and Howard Gudahl of Howard, South Dakota. He was preceded in death by one son, Robert. Mr. Gudahl is also survived by 24 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren.
