

Victor Carroll Gudahl

Funeral services for Victor Carroll Gudahl, 69, were held Monday, August 29, 1994, at 10 a.m. at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, with Dan Driggs and Andy Gudahl, Ministers, officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Gudahl died Thursday, August 25, 1994, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland after a lengthy illness.

Victor was born August 30, 1924, on the family homestead at Bordeaux, Wyoming, the son of Oscar Bernhard and Grace Viola (Broyles) Gudahl. Victor lived and ranched on the family homestead all of his life. He attended the Marks School, District No. 1 Platte County and then graduated from Wheatland High School. Upon graduation he joined the United States Navy in August, 1943, and served until March, 1946. During World War II he served on several Landing Ship Tankers. After the war, he returned to the family homestead where he ranched and farmed with his father. Victor enjoyed playing cards, watching sporting events, reading, and his nieces and nephews.

He is survived by four brothers and two sisters, Joyce Settell, Don Gudahl, and Andy Gudahl, all of Wheatland, Wyoming, Richard Gudahl of Gering, Neb., Gene Gudahl of Cheyenne, and Alice "Jo" Parriott of Bayard, Neb., and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Bob Gudahl.

Serving as pallbearers were Steve Gudahl, Robert Gudahl, Vince Birkle, Brent Parriott, and Dan Gudahl. Honorary pallbearers were all of his many friends.
