

Margaret Haerberle, Wheatland Pioneer, Succumbs Sunday

Mrs. Margaret A. Haerberle, 82, a Wheatland pioneer, passed away Sunday, March 16, 1975 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. She had been a resident here for 69 years.

Funeral services for Mrs. Haerberle were held Tuesday, March 18, 1975 at the United Church of Christ. Rev. Gordon Tritchler conducted the ceremony. Burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Haerberle was born in the Oklahoma Territory January 5, 1893. When she was 13, she came with her parents by covered wagon to Wheatland from Colorado in 1906. She married Arch Clark Haerberle May 17, 1911 in Golden City, Mo. He passed away May 22, 1947.

Mrs. Haerberle was a member of the Congregational Church, the V.F.W. Auxiliary and the Dorcas Society.

She is survived by one son, A. C. Haerberle, Jr.; three grandchildren, Mrs. Norma Hunt and Lance of Wheatland and Stephen of Lander; by one great grandchild; and by three sisters, Mrs. Stella Stonaker of Salem, Oregon, Mrs. Verla Kirby of Watsonville, Calif., and Mrs. Mildred Loomis of Powell, Wyo.

She was preceded in death by a daughter, Norma Frances Haerberle in 1942.
