

Zonetta Mae Haeberle

Funeral services for Zonetta Mae Haeberle, 88, will be held at 11 a.m. Friday, Dec. 2, at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, with Pastor Joe Bair officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery. A reception will be held at the Wheatland Country Club from 12-3 p.m.

Zonetta Haeberle died Friday, Nov. 25, at the Platte County Legacy Home in Wheatland.

She was born Sunday, March 4, 1928 in Wheatland, Wyoming the daughter of Harry and Mary Elizabeth (Peters) Marshall and was the youngest of nine children. The Marshall family lived in a farm house southwest of Wheatland, where Zonetta attended Rock Lake and Curtis country schools thru the eighth grade. She graduated from the Wheatland High School in 1945. She worked as a reception at the Wheatland Hospital and then as a telephone operator.

Zonetta was married to Arch "Clark" Haeberle on Feb. 24, 1948 and was a devoted wife and mother to their three children, Stephen, Norma, and Lance. Zonetta was supportive of all of Clark's many community activities.

She entered the real estate profession in 1977 and retired in 1988. She was a member of the United Church of Christ in Wheatland and was the first charter member of the Wheatland Coun-

try Club.

Zonetta is survived by her son, Lance Haeberle, of Frisco, Colorado; grandchildren, Brian Hunt, Stefanie Hunt, Quincy Haeberle, and Crystal Haeberle; and great grandchildren, Leo and Ella Rae.
