

HAGERMAN, EARL C.
October 3, 1909-July 2, 1944

Pfc. Earl C. Hagerman, 33, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry R. Hagerman, was killed in action in France on July 2, according to a wire received by his parents from the war department, Saturday, September 2.

Born in Florence, Colo., October 3, 1909, he moved to this community with his parents at the age of 3, and received his education in the Wheatland schools. He was inducted into the service in March of 1942, and received his basic training at Camp Barkeley, Tex. He had been serving overseas with the infantry since March of this year.

Besides his parents, he is survived by four brothers, Floyd who was reported last week as being a German prisoner of war, George of Chugwater, Glen and Gene; and two sisters, Mildred and Gladys.
