Graveside services and inurnment for Frank David Haggerty, 37, were held Tuesday, May 16, 1995 at 2 p.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery, with Reverend Brud Coy officiating. Frank died Saturday, May 13, 1995 in Riverton, Wyo.

He was born Dec. 6, 1957 in Wheatland, the son of Charles and Virginia (Vollman) Haggerty. He was reared and educated in the Wheatland area, attending schools in Wheatland, Glenrock, Casper and Ft. Laramie. He was a rodeo cowboy for a number of years, and was the Greenland Champion Bull Rider of 1984.

He began working in the masonry business about 1979 and worked at that until the time of his death. He owned the Windriver Masonry in Riverton. He married Katy Addison in Riverton on May 4, 1995. His hobbies were rodeo, hunting and fishing. He loved the mountains.
