

HALE, ROBERT
June 10, 1877-July 6, 1941

Robert Hale, resident of the community since 1914, passed away at his home 10 miles north of his Wheatland, early Sunday morning, July 6.

Robert Hale was born June 10, 1877 in Sheridan, Iowa and made his home here for 27 years. He had been ill for some time prior to his death, and his brothers from Kansas were called to his bed-side early in the week before he died.

Mr. Hale was a member of the Christian church and of the Odd Fellows lodge. Services were held on Tuesday at 2:30 p.m. at the Christian church with Rev. Waddell officiating and Watson and Dennis in charge, with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.

Robert Hale is survived by his wife, Emma Hale, a daughter, Mrs. Vera Reed of Cheyenne, one granddaughter and one great grandson; two sisters, Mrs. Annie Williams of Kansas City Kans..
