

HALL, LEWIS CARL
February 12, 1889-December 3, 1962

Lewis Carl Hall, born in Anderson, S.C., Feb. 12, 1889, died in Cody, Wyoming Dec 3, 1962, after an extended illness. He had been a rancher in the Laramie Peak area since 1905, and was a veteran of World War I.

Rev. Irvin Noyce conducted the services held at the Schrader chapel Dec. 6, and interment was at the Wheatland cemetery. Military honors were held at the graveside.
