

# Robert Frederick Halter

Funeral services for Robert Frederick Halter, age 61, were held at the Platte Funeral Chapel Tuesday, Jan. 2, at 2 p.m., with Andy Gudahl officiating. Mr. Halter died Dec. 29 in Wheatland.

He was born June 21, 1928 at Albany, N.Y., the son of Robert I. and Minnie (Ryder) Halter. He was educated in New York where he graduated from high school. He then attended the Rensselaer Poly Tech.

Following his graduation from Rensselaer, he went to work for the State of New York as a design engineer. From 1950 to 1953, he served in the U.S. Army.

On Nov. 7, 1953, he married Jane Love in Arlington, Va.

In 1959, they moved to Washington, D.C., where he worked for the Potomac River Naval Command as a design engineer. He retired in 1969, and in 1980, they moved to Laramie. In 1988, they moved to Wheatland.

He is survived by his wife, Jane, of the home, one son, William R. Halter of Rockville, Maryland, and one brother, John Krouse of Poughkeepsie, N.Y.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother.
