

HAMMER, JOHANNA M. KNUDSEN

January 24, 1870-October 5, 1944

Mrs. Johanna M. Hammer, 74, of Glendo, was found dead at her home Saturday afternoon, October 7. It is believed she had been dead at least two days, and death of attributed to natural causes.

Mrs. Hammer was born January 24, 1870 in Copenhagen, Denmark and came to this country as a small child. She had been a resident of Glendo for the past 15 years and was the widow of the late Walter Hammer who passed away in 1932.

Survivors include two sisters, Mrs. Carl Sorensen and Mrs. Rendina Neilsen of Denver; and three brothers, Bearney and Karl Knudsen of Denver, and Niels Knudsen of California.

Funeral services were held in the Schrader chapel Monday at 4:30 p.m. with the Rev. D.F. Chaffin officiating, and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
