

HANKINS, DAVID ADEN
June 8, 1897-November 3, 1973

Funeral services were held Thursday, November 8, 1973 at 2 p.m. at the Schrader Chapel for David Aden Hankins with the Rev. Gordon Tritchler officiating.

Mr. Hankins, 76, passed away Saturday, November 3, 1973 at the St. Johns Hospital in Springfield, Missouri following a three week illness.

Mr. Hankins was born in Taylor County, Iowa, on June 8, 1897. He moved to Slater, Wyoming in 1929 and lived there until 1960 when he moved to Marshfield, Mo. where he was living at the time of his death.
