

9-5 BARTON M. (JACK) HARRIS 1984

Funeral services for Barton M. (Jack) Harris, 57, who died Sept. 5 in Wheatland were held at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel Sat., Sept. 8 at 10:30 a.m. with Pastor Scott Leonard officiating.

Born May 16, 1927 in Hazelgreen, Mo., Harris was the son of John W. and Martha Bowling Harris. He received his education and spent his childhood in Missouri.

In 1945 he served in the U.S. Army and upon his discharge came to Wheatland. He married Elsie Manweiler in Wheatland, Feb. 8, 1948, and soon after they moved to Toledo, Ore., where they remained until 1962. They then moved to Colorado where he worked for Great Western. He retired in 1963 and they returned to Wheatland.

Besides his wife he is survived by two sons: Terry E. Harris of Wheatland and Paul B. Harris of Cheyenne; a daughter, Theresa Harris of Wheatland; four brothers: Dolphus Harris of Siletz, Ore., Grover Harris of Nebo, Mo., Paul Harris of Newport, Ore., and James Harris of Wheatland; five sisters: Jessie Singer of Overland Park, Kan., Nina McMillan of Jefferson City, Mo., Genevieve Payne of Glendo, Helen Hall of Walden, N.Y. and Bonnie Thompson of Seneca, S.
