

HARTER, MARTHA ELIZABETH COLLINS

February 7, 1879-June 16, 1944

Mrs. F.S. Harter, 65, a resident of Wheatland for the past 28, died at the Wheatland General hospital last Friday, June 16, at 9:45 p.m. from a sudden illness.

Funeral services were held from the Christian church Tuesday at 2:30 p.m. with Mr. Clarke Devore officiating. Mrs. Harry Mills and Mrs. Roy Purcell, accompanied by Mrs. John Peters, sang. Graveside services were in charge of the Rebekah lodge and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Martha Elizabeth Collins was born February 7, 1879 in Coffeerville, Kan., and was the only daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H.W. Collins. She was married to F.S. Harter in Wheatland on December 24, 1919. Mrs. Harter was affiliated with the Christian church and was a devoted member of the W.T.C.U. of which she was president. She was an active member of the Rebekah lodge and had filled every office, being a past Noble Grand at the time of her death. She was also a member of the Daughters of Civil War Veterans and the Republican Women's club.

Besides her husband, she is survived by a brother, James Collins of Wheatland, a half brother, Clyde Collins of Chapin, Ia. ad several nephews and nieces.
