

HARVEY, HILDA MARIE LARSON

May 4, 1899-September 13, 1981

Hilda Marie Harvey, 82, died Sunday, Sept. 13, 1981 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing.

Hilda, the daughter of Frederick A. and Minnie Anderson Larson was born May 4, 1899 in Deer Creek, Oklahoma Territory. Her early childhood and school days were spent at Gallio, a small community north of Pine Bluffs, Wyo. She was united marriage with R. Earl Harvey, who was a Slater homesteader, on June 10, 1971 in Cheyenne. Following the ceremony they came to Earl's homestead on the Slater Flats to make their home. They retired in the 1950's leaving the farming operation to the family. They spent a few of their retired years in California. She had been residing near her daughter's home in Yuma, Ariz., the past three and a half years. She was visiting her son, Robert Harvey, and family near Slater earlier in the summer. She was a charter member of Slater Women's Club when it was organized in 1936.

She is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Arnold (Hazel) Bomgardner of Casa Grande, Ariz., Mrs. Gene L. (Barbara) Jones of Yuma, Ariz., and Mrs. Hubert (Kathleen) Hopkins of Mesa, Ariz.; one son, Robert W. Harvey of Slater; eight grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren, one great great grandson; one brother, Elmer Larson of California. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Earl, April 24, 1974; one brother; one sister and one grandson, Michael Jones.

Services were held at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel Wednesday, Sept. 16, 1981 at 2 p.m. with the Rev. Delbert Dick officiating.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
