

HARWOOD, MINNIE LEOLA DOWDEN

May 17, 1880-June 13, 1954

Funeral services for Minnie Leola Harwood, 74, will be held at Schader's chapel tomorrow (Friday) at 2:30 p.m., and burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery. Officiating clergyman will be the Rev. J.B. Milstead and pallbearers will be Carl West, Richard Chase, Alvin Jessen, George Woolsey, Sam Goit and Jake Axford.

The daughter of Albidge and Susan Dowden, Mrs. Harwood was born at Crawfordville, Ind., May 17, 1880 and died at Evanston, June 13, following an extended illness. She attended school in Indiana and was married in 1898 to James A. Harwood. Six children were born to this union. The family moved to Texas in 1907, and to Oklahoma in 1909. In 1914 they came to Wyoming, where she had since made her home. She was a member of the Church of God.

Surviving are four daughters, Mrs. Violet E. Stofflet and Mrs. Lelia Christensen of Wheatland, Mrs. Martha M. Teel of Elwood, Nebr. and Mrs. Virgie Owens of Kingman, Ind.; a son, James L.
